Getting an Address

Addresses for new sites are assigned through the 911 Coordinator, located with the County Engineer's office. You can contact them at 979-826-7702.

General Permits

Most construction-related permits, such as septic and culverts, are handled through the Waller County Engineering Department. You can also find flood area information here. You can contact them at 979-826-7670.

Fire Codes

Waller County has adopted the 2009 International Fire Code and applies to most new construction projects within the unincorporated areas of the county. If you are planning a new building, or a substantial remodel to an existing building within the county, please visit the county web site for more information, or call 979-826-7670.

G&W Water Supply

If you are looking north of US Hwy 290, you need to know that a CCN has been issued to G&W Water Supply Corp. Before starting a project, call them at 936-372-9858.
